## ***Connect people within their communities***

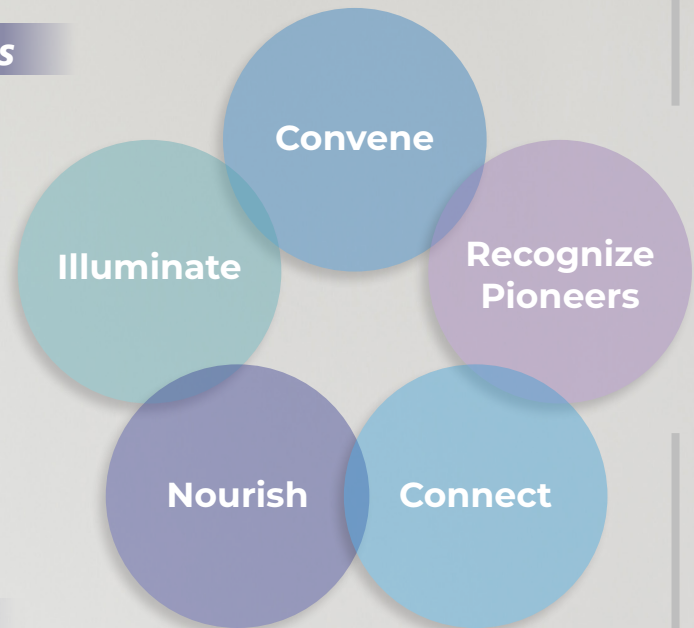
to build strong working relationships that strengthen capacity to deliver great care that is equitable and just.
